1,100 Tons of Steel!

This past summer, ground was broken on the Archdiocese of Philadelphia's newest school, Pope John Paul II High School. Most recently on the jobsite, steel was erected for the 209,000 sf facility located at the intersection of Rittenhouse and Township Line Roads

in Upper Providence Township, Montgomery County. Above is a progress photo showing a portion of the 1,100 tons of steel that will make up the 1,200 student, state-of-the-art facility, which sits on a 92-acre parcel.

This project marks the first of two high schools EDiS will be completing for the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. The project is due to be completed in Fall 2010.
